#### How to write structured abstract?

- 1) Abstracts should contain no more than 250 words.
- 2) The abstract should followe these headings:
- > Purpose: What are the reason(s) for writing the paper or the aims of it?
- Design/methodology/approach: How are the objectives achieved? Include the main method(s) used for the research. What is the approach to the topic and what is the theoretical or subject scope of the paper?
- Findings: What was found in the course of the work? This will refer to analysis, discussion, or results.

- Research limitations/implications (if applicable): for future research and any identified limitations in the research process.
- ➤ Practical implications (if applicable): What outcomes and implications for practice, applications and consequences are identified? How will the research impact upon the business or enterprise? What changes to practice should be made as a result of this research? What is the commercial or economic impact? Not all papers will have practical implications.
- Originality/value: What is new in the paper? State the value of the paper and to whom.

## Plagiarism Avoidance:

- Stanford sees plagiarism as the "use, without giving reasonable and appropriate credit to or acknowledging the author or source, of another person's original work, whether such work is made up of code, formulas, ideas, language, research, strategies, writing or other form."
- Yale views plagiarism as the "... use of another's work, words, or ideas without attribution," which includes "... using a source's language without quoting, using information from a source without attribution, and paraphrasing a source in a form that stays too close to the original."
- Oxford College of Emory University characterizes plagiarism as "the use of "a writer's ideas or phraseology without giving due credit."
- The U.S. Naval Academy defines plagiarism as "the use of the words, information, insights, or ideas of another without crediting that person through proper citation."
